# INDIA ANNOUNCED 12 MILLION DOLLAR GRANT India-Pacific Islands Leaders' Meeting 24 Sept 2019, New York

PM Narendra Modi met leaders of the Pacific Small Islands Developing States (PSIDS) on the sidelines of the UN General Assembly session in New York. ### NON STOVE COOKING: LASSI OR DESI MILK SHAKES
